

COVID-19 Testing Options for North Central Campus Community Members

- **Illinois Department of Public Health Testing Sites** (<https://dph.illinois.gov/testing>)
 - Testing is free at these locations.
 - Insurance is not required nor is a healthcare provider's order in order to get tested.
 - Testing availability is limited each day.
 - It typically takes at least 5-7 days to get the test results back.
- **Local Health Department Testing Sites**
 - For example, DuPage County Health Department (<https://www.dupagehealth.org/601/COVID-19-Testing>)
 - Testing is free at these locations.
 - Insurance is not required nor is a healthcare provider's order in order to get tested.
 - Testing availability is limited each day.
 - It typically takes at least 3-4 days to get the test results back.

- **VNA Health Care**

 - Testing is available by appointment only at 4 different locations.
 - Accept various healthcare insurance plans; however, health insurance is not required
 - Will need to be screened and evaluated by a healthcare provider prior to testing
 - Testing is available only Mondays-Fridays.
- **Pillars Community Health**

 - Testing is available for symptomatic and exposed individuals.
 - Testing is available by appointment only on Tuesdays and Thursdays
 - Will bill insurance for testing. Those without insurance should call (708) 745-5277 to discuss options.
 - Testing is limited each testing day.
- **CVS** (<https://www.cvs.com/minuteclinic/covid-19-testing>)
 - Drive-thru testing is available for symptomatic and exposed individuals
 - Appointments and pre-screening questionnaire are required.

- Health insurance is required
- Test results are available within at least 6-10 days
- **Physician's Immediate Care** (<https://physiciansimmediatecare.com/covid-19-testing-locations/>)
 - Walk-up or drive-up for testing
 - Testing availability is limited each day.
 - An evaluation by a healthcare provider on-site is required prior to testing.
 - Insurance is required. For individuals without insurance, if you qualify for testing, then it will cost approximately \$165 for an examination and then \$75 for testing.
 - Both a rapid test (Abbott ID), which takes 15 minutes to get the results, and a send out viral PCR test will be performed.
 - It takes 7-days to get the results back from the send out lab.
- **Edward-Elmhurst Health** (<https://www.eehealth.org/coronavirus/screening-options/>)
 - Testing is available at 9 locations in the western suburbs
 - Testing is available following either an evaluation at an immediate care or with an order from a healthcare provider affiliated with Edward-Elmhurst Health (i.e., through a video visit)
 - Will bill insurance.
 - It takes approximately 3-5 days to get test results back.

At-Home Kit

- **Pixel by Lab Corps Test Kits** (<https://www.pixel.labcorp.com/covid-19>)
 - Self-collected nasal at-home test kits
 - Cost is \$119/kit. Insurance will be billed. For those who are uninsured, will utilize financial assistance through the CARES ACT.
 - Test results are available approximately 3-5 days from receipt at the lab.
- **Everlywell COVID-19 Test Kits** (<https://www.everlywell.com/products/covid-19-test/>)
 - Self-collected nasal at-home test kits
 - Cost is \$109/kit and insurance will be billed
 - Test taker must be 18-years or older
 - Test results are available within approximately 72-hours from receipt at the lab to get results.
 - Only 1 test kit per household
